G-F Grad Events, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) non-profit charitable organization established to plan events and gather support from the community for charitable programs and services directed toward the well-being of youth and families within the community.

Annually, Gar-Field Grad Events will award scholarships based on academic achievement, community service and need. Scholarships will be awarded to Gar-Field High School senior(s) who best meet the requirements set forth by the Scholarship Committee. Scholarship awards are limited to cover tuition and fees. *Four \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded in 2020.*

Scholarship recipients will be notified by May 11, 2020.

GUIDELINES FOR THE GAR-FIELD GRAD EVENTS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Scholarships are open to graduating Gar-Field High School seniors. Scholarship monies will be paid directly to the educational institution in the student's name.

Student applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Plan to attend, or currently attend an accredited college or university, business school or technical/trade school on a full-time basis.
- 2. Must have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale.
- 3. Must have acquired acceptance to the educational institution of his/her choice and must be an enrolled full-time student for the fall semester of 2020.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. All questions must be answered. Incomplete applications will be disqualified. Please use N/A to indicate unable to answer. Leave no blanks.
- 2. The application form can be picked up from the Guidance Office at Gar-Field High School, and found on the Gar-Field Grad Events website, www.gfgradevents.org.
- 3. Attach additional sheets as needed in order to complete questions 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, or 12.
- 4. Applications must include the following:
 - Complete application form, including essays
 - Two letters of reference from a Gar-Field High School teacher or guidance counselor.
 - A copy of your most recent high school transcript
- Applications must be received by Monday, April 6, 2020. <u>THERE WILL BE NO</u> <u>EXCEPTIONS</u>. Please advise your high school registrar of this deadline for submission of transcripts and other supporting documentation.
- Successful applicants will be notified on or before May 11, 2020.
 Note: Scholarship awards are limited to cover tuition and fees. Amounts awarded to successful candidates are at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee.
